You may agree or disagree with the views below. Feel free to comment on them.

There is an alternative to putting Glendale Career College at 240 N Brand. The DPSS Building or the old Police Building (OPB). It appears there are no plans for either. Vanguard had suggested that the city move the Council chambers and offices along with the City Clerk to the OPB. That would allow for expansion to City Attorney, Management Services and Parks and Recreation. Of course the OPB could become an incubator for non-profits to learn how to effectively obtain grants from outside sources to better provide for needed services to the City. This does take VISION. Something that is sorely lacking.

The new Downtown Specific Plan (DPS): Do we need it? What happened to the one put together in the mid 90s by Glendale Partners? The present planning starts off with nightclubs. Vanguard has nothing against a nightclub but until the Vision is defined, is that the best use? Wouldn't the best use be dependent on the Vision?

The City calls for a mobility study. CM Yousefian calls for a trolley. How can you call for a trolley without a Vision or mobility study? How about an elevated people mover? A moving sidewalk with terminus at the shopping district and the hotel district or at a parking structure? Downtown Las Vegas has the Fremont experience. A wonderful nightly laser light show. Truly an attraction to the restaurant, club, theater and museum district on Brand.

Vanguard was presented with a fantastic idea for a Franchise Exhibit Hall. It would keep the hotels and restaurants full. Glendale best glom onto the idea before a progressive city does.

The community involvement in the DPS is good. We must remember that we CAN speak up. Ask questions, determine whose idea something is. Preferred use is from staff.

A reminder on OPEN Government – Below you will find elements of an open government. These elements are mandated by law.

Brown Act – This Act sets the parameters on the conduct of legislative meetings including the agenda and oral comments. Vanguard has reproduced a one page Brown Act available upon request.

CPRA – This is the California Public Records Act that requires California governmental agencies provide public documents upon your request for review or purchase for no more than 10¢ per page. Vanguard can provide you with assistance or a recommended form.

SEI Form 700 – Almost every elected and appointed office holder and top manager is required to file a Statement of Economic Interest. In Glendale it is with the City Clerk. This has to be filed annually, within 30 days of assuming and leaving office. There are penalties for failure to file. According to the City Attorney, Redevelopment Agency and Housing Authority do have to file.

The city failed to enforce the law for officials whose records are not forwarded to the state until recently, said Barry Allen, a Glendale resident and publisher of Vanguard, an online local government watchdog newsletter. "The city is starting to

track them now," Allen said. "They didn't before, but Vanguard kicked and pushed and now they are maintaining a list of those who are delinquent."

Crime Tip: Be aware of your surroundings. Know what cars are parked in your neighborhood. Keep a watchful eye for tailgaters and followers when you are driving. Elements of Campaign Finance Reform:

- 1. Limit the amount of money a candidate or committee can accept from a contributor. Exclude City Unions from contributing to candidates.** *ART XXIII of Charter - Sec. 25. Political activity or contributions on part of city manager, etc. Neither the city manager, nor any person in the employ of the city shall take any active part in securing, or shall contribute money toward the nomination or election of any candidate for a municipal office. City unions have spent almost \$90,000 on council.*
- 2. Councilmanic Districts – Look about you, so many cities have districts as do the Feds, State and County**
- 3. Term limits -- Eight years should be sufficient to get your vision and programs in place**
- 4. Resign – Resign from one public office before running for another**

This can be accomplished by asking City Council to sponsor a Charter Amendment to add these elements of Campaign Reform

Queries under CPRA and responses from City of Glendale

REQUEST: Provide Employee Assistance Program reports as to use of EAP by employees and dependents. Provide Employee Health Services reports as to use of EHS by employees and dependents for domestic violence, gambling, drug and alcohol addiction. Employee Census (Including dependents, retirees) for Blue Cross PPO, Blue Cross HMO, Kaiser and Cigna

RESPONSE: Your request for a "list of employees signed up for each health medical care insurance program" constitute privileged medical information and therefore are exempt from production pursuant to Government Code Section 6254(c).

MODIFIED REQUEST: Regarding census information: Please provide the same census information that is provided to insurance companies for their insurance proposals. Feel free to redact the names of any employees or as an alternative please provide the census data that proves the need for the programs. The request was for a census, not a list of names.

How can you trust a City when they spend so much of the time trying to avoid giving the public the correct and accurate answers to valid questions? Here is a request and the response from City Attorney...

STORY BEHIND THE HEADLINE: City pays \$6M for Flint Canyon and 10 acres (Gregg). Appraisal based on the use of the land for housing that won't happen. The raw land was purchased by Flint Canyon LLC (Gangi) in 1999 for \$475K and assessed by the County at \$365K. Not a bad deal for the seller. Did the city (us) take it in the shorts? That is what happens when the City does these things in secret!! Does Weaver have an interest? Gangi is a supporter of the Miss Asia program of which Weaver is on the 'Executive Committee'. Miss Asia is a production on Virgelia Productions and is a for profit business. Part of the Miss Asia contest took place in Pasadena at the Ambassador College property under the control of Dorn Platz, the same Dorn Platz that Weaver has championed for the rebuilding of 240 N Brand and the properties north of the Alex Theater. **See Item #3 Dorn-Platz – Career College**

After Barry Allen spoke on behalf of Vanguard, Weaver said that as Allen wasn't invited to the many closed sessions, he would have no idea as to the discussion (what went on). **Mr. Weaver, when you disclose the cancelled checks, the income and bank statement to the Dreaming of Roses bank account (B of A) – Mr. Allen will divulge his secret session source!!**

Response: Building and Safety is aware of the unauthorized work, and has already instructed the applicant that such work is not approved, and that permits must be secured or the work must be restored to its original condition. The applicant has not yet secured permits for the work, and may be attempting to get necessary approvals and/or clearances lined up.
